

GARNER HOLIDAY EVENT STREET CLOSURE DETAILS

LIGHT UP MAIN CLOSURES

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 4

BEFORE AND DURING THE EVENT

5:00 p.m. -10:00 p.m.

The following streets will be closed to all traffic 5:00 p.m. until the close of the parade:

Main Street (from Purvis Street to Griffin Street)
Rand Mill Road (from Main Street to the dead end)

In addition, we ask businesses and residents to remove all cars from Main Street by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 5. If possible, please avoid parking on Main Street as of 3:00 p.m. as this will greatly assist with set up.

During these times when streets are closed all residents will have access to their homes, with the exception of those residents who live on Rand Mill Road and second story residents in the 100 West block of Main Street.

CHRISTMAS PARADE CLOSURES

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5

BEFORE & DURING THE PARADE

11:30 a.m. – End of Parade

The following streets will be closed to all traffic, except parade participants and street residents, from 11:30 a.m. until the end of the parade. These roads will be used for parade participant entry staging and will be closed to any cars that are not residents of the North Garner area or do not have a parade participant pass. North Garner residents in the affected areas received a road closure memo and can use this as proof of residency if needed.

IF YOU LIVE ON OR NEAR ONE OF THE STREETS ALONG THE PARADE STAGING ROUTE, PLEASE MAKE TRAVEL PLANS WITH THESE STREET CLOSURES IN MIND.

Broughton Street (from Garner Road to Powell Drive)

This street will be one way allowing only for parade participants & residents to enter the streets surrounding the Garner Performing Arts Center. *All parade participants must enter through Broughton Street.*

Powell Drive (from Broughton Street to Avery Street)

This street will be one way, allowing only for parade participants to enter and park on the streets nearby or in the North Garner Middle School lots. People dropping off participants will be asked to park on nearby streets.

Avery Street (from Powell Drive to Garner Road)

For the safety of our participants, during parade line-up this street will be entirely closed to through traffic. At the end of the parade, this street will be one way, only allowing participant cars to travel south towards Garner Road to exit the parade area.

**DURING THE PARADE
1:30 P.M. –END OF PARADE**

The parade will begin at the intersection of Garner Road and Avery Street and will travel down Garner Road to New Rand Road. The parade will take a right on New Rand Road, turn right onto Main Street and proceed to Benson Road. The parade will turn right onto Benson Road and cross under the train tracks, where it will end at the intersection of Garner Road and Benson Road (by Toot n' Tell).

The following streets along the parade route will be closed to through traffic from 1:30 p.m. until the end of the parade.
IF YOU LIVE ON OR NEAR ONE OF THE STREETS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE, PLEASE PLAN TRAVEL ACCORDINGLY.

- Garner Road** (from Weston Road to Jones Sausage Road)
- Benson Road** (from Umstead Drive to Garner Road)
- Main Street** (from Benson Road to New Rand Road)
- Creech Road** (from Creech Road Elementary to Garner Road)
- North Montague Street** (from Highway 70 to Main Street)

OTHER AFFECTED STREETS

The following streets will be blocked as they intersect with Garner Road and Main Street to restrict access to these main thoroughfares during the parade. Entry for parking or travel to/on Garner Road and Main Street will not be allowed from these areas from 1:30 p.m. until the end of the parade.

Streets intersecting with Garner Road:

- Cedar Lane
- Center Street
- Cofield Alley
- Harper Street
- Penny Street
- Creech Road

Streets intersecting with Main Street:

- St Mary's Street
- Pearl Street
- North Montague Street
- Purvis Street
- Rand Mill Road
- Griffin Street
- Bagwell Street
- Carroll Drive
