

 - 83% Manufacturing/Assembly
 - 4% Warehouse Distribution
 - 3% Research and Development
- Real Estate Requests
 - 38% of requests needed a building
 - 37% of requests needed a site
 - 70% of building requests needed 100,000 SF or more
 - 41% of site requested needed 50+ acres







- Schedule of General Obligation Bond Issuances
- FY 2023 \$21,620,000
 - Bond sale closed on June 21, 2023
- FY 2025 \$30,196,666
- FY 2027 \$17,183,334
